- Alteration of freshwater inflow into bays and estuaries
- Condition of living resources
- Loss of wetlands and estuarine habitats
- Degradation of water and sediment quality
- Altered estuarine circulation
- 6. Increasing amounts of bay debris
- Selected public health issues
- Declining coastal bird populations
- Resilient coastal ecosystems and human communities that can adapt to changing conditions
- Implementation of effective adaptive management practices at CBBEP properties
- Well-educated public to be wise stewards of the environment.



THINGS TO KEEP IN MIND . . .

- Allow sufficient time and budget for QAPP
- Need active SAM registration / UEI numbers
- Bipartisan Infrastructure Law Funds:
 - Starts in November
 - ADA Compatibility for public access
 - Signage required for "moving dirt" projects
 - "Buy America Build America" applies to projects over \$250,000

BIPARTISAN INFRASTRUCTURE LAW FUNDING

- Currently implementing both the FY22/23 Work Plan and FY24 Work Plan
- Getting ready to start implement our FY25 Work Plan
- FINAL year of funding beginning the development of our FY26 Work Plan
- CBBEP is using 5-year grant periods for these EPA contracts opportunity to think about projects with longer timelines
- Looking for project ideas in these priority areas:
 - Stormwater management (particularly green infrastructure)
 - Nutrient reduction strategies (particularly wastewater inputs)
 - Habitat Restoration/Shoreline protection (including rookery islands)
 - Public access
 - Carbon sequestration
 - Invasive species control
