Entry form must be completed and paperclipped on the back of the artwork (parent/guardian signature required)

Only one entry allowed per student

CONTEST RULES

Must be student's original artwork (no help from an adult)

Artwork must represent our local estuaries (see below for suggestions and examples)

8.5x11 inch white paper (horizontal and no loose-leaf paper)

Crayons, paint, marker and colored pencils allowed (cannot be computer generated)

* If rules are not followed, the artwork will be disqualified *

SUGGESTIONS FOR ARTWORK

* Artwork must represent Texas estuaries*

Estuary Landscapes

Recreational Activities Enjoyed in an Estuary (Examples: fishing, boating, bird watching, kayaking, wildlife viewing)

Texas Wildlife and Plants
(Examples: great blue herons, oysters, blue crab, diamondback terrapin, roseate spoonbills, red drum, speckled trout, mangroves, cord grass)

Prevention Awareness (Examples: littering, habitat destruction, invasive species, overfishing)
